FOR FOREIGN
PARTICIPANTS IN SCHOLARSHIP
PROGRAMS:

Information about the provision of care to foreign participants in scholarship programs from developing countries.

The scholarship program you are participating in gives you the right to receive free medical care within the Czech Republic throughout the duration of the scholarship. This care is paid for by the Ministry of Health.

WHO PAYS FOR THE CARE:

The care for scholarship recipients is paid for by the Ministry of Health within the framework of bilateral foreign development cooperation, based on Czech Republic Government Resolution No. 618 of 8 June 2020. Scholarship status / entitlement to reimbursement of health care can be verified at: http://registr.dzs.cz/dotaz.nsf/dotaz

FOR WHOM IS THE CARE PAID:

For the student - scholarship recipient who submits to the physician a document from the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports entitled Decision on awarding a scholarship from the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports to support studies by foreigners at public universities in the Czech Republic. The decision states the students name, surname, date of birth, nationality and date until which they are a scholarship recipient.



WHAT CARE IS PAID FOR BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH:

The Ministry pays for care on behalf of the scholarship recipient in the same scope as the care paid for Czech insurance holders. This means that the care paid from the public health insurance scheme will be paid by Ministry of Health, while unpaid care (e.g. surcharges for medicines, deductibles for certain medical equipment) will be paid by the scholarship recipient.
